Organizing and/or subsidizing students to participate in joint-school/cross-curricular activities relating to the CSD curriculum held in Hong Kong or in the Mainland	To subsidize students' travelling expenses incurred by student participation in school-based learning activities in Hong Kong (closely linked with the curriculum of CSD, e.g. visits to exhibitions, field trips and experiential learning).	\$3,200
